COVID Protocols

Government Guidelines are due to change on 21st June.

At present the following considerations will need to be taken into account:

Our risk assessments are updated

Bring a face covering and at least one spare

Bring own hand sanitiser

Tent and Group Bubbles should remain separate.

No mixing with other schools (a boundary in the woods will be put in place to support this)

Bubbles & Tent sharing:



- 5 students per tent some student choice
- Activity Bubbles
 (3 tents = 1 group)
 no student choice
- Year groups remain separate bubbles
- No mixing with other years or schools



Students are expected to follow staff instructions at all times

Behaviour Expectations



In the event of any concerns – students should see a member of staff in the first instance and not try and contact home first.



This is a digital detox and so the use of phones or other digital devices is prohibited.

What does the camping involve?

Tents

 Tents are supplied by Blackland Farm

 Two sizes of tents both sleep 5 students comfortably

 Students put up their own tents after a demonstration by teachers





What does the camping involve?







- All meals are included in the price of the trip (except lunch on Tuesday)
- Food is prepared by students and cooked on altars (similar to a BBQ with flames) – under close supervision
- Breakfast/ Lunch/ Evening Meal and snacks are provided
- Food is prepared separately in order to meet medical & nutritional needs
- Tuck Shop: Allocated times with staff with face coverings
- Specific Dietary Requirements on Operoo

Leaving and Returning

Students should arrive at school around 8.30am and meet in the Hall (coaches are due at 9.30am). Luggage will be placed in Coach areas at the front of school.

We will be returning for approximately 2.30pm. Students should make arrangements to be collected with their luggage.

Leaving & Returning

- Saturday 10th Lateral flow test staff and students
- Any inconclusive PCR test
- Tuesday 13th July Students should arrive at school around 8.30am and meet in the field (coaches are due at 9.30am). Luggage will be placed in Coach areas at the front of school.
- Staff Testing Re-testing throughout week
- Friday We will be returning for approximately 2.30pm

Arriving at Blackland Farm

- Students will arrive at Blackland on Tuesday and in their tent groups will put up a tent.
- Activities will commence on Tuesday





Leaving Blackland Farm

- Friday students will;
 - pack bags in the morning
 - pack up tents
 - have lunch
 - carry out morning activities
 - Tidy field
 - Return to school for approx. 3.00pm

Return to the Academy

- Coaches will have staggered return
- We plan for year 7s will arrive first
- Parents will receive a text for arrival time
- It can get very busy!
- Students will be seated on the field
- Students <u>must</u> be registered before being collected by parents/guardian
- We <u>must</u> know that all students are collected safely
- If students are walking home unaccompanied please inform the academy in advance
